The privilege of participating in cooking class will be a direct reflection of your ability to follow the expectations that are industry standards in the culinary profession.

If you choose to not abide by these standards you will not be permitted to participate in cooking.

There is no room in this classroom for horse play. There are knives, hot ovens, stoves and food safety regulations where your actions could result in harm to you or others. No chances will be taken on safety.

The following are the expectations and guidelines expected of all who enter the kitchen:

All kitchen equipment will be used appropriately. No snapping towels. Knives will be used safely, point to the ground and handed to partners with handle not knife end.

When you are instructed by the adult in the room to complete a task, you will comply first time. All dishes will be cleaned and in their appropriate place before you leave the classroom. Time management is very important, making sure you have completed all assigned tasks is an essential life skill.

You will work together in making the recipes for the day. Everyone is expected to help complete recipes and clean stations. It is not this person or that person's job to do a specific task but instead is the responsibility of the whole group. We want this to be a fun time for everyone.

Disrespect towards adults or anyone else in the room is not tolerated.
